## 2.0 Party Game For Small Groups – 2 to 6 People

### 2.1. Illusion Juggler

#### Aim of The Game:

A group game where the group creates the optical illusion of juggling a large number of balls.

#### Instructions:

People are to stand in a circle. Then determine a throwing pattern around the circle. For example, person 1 throws to person 3 who throws to 2 who throws to 6 who throws to 3 who throws to 1 again.

Start with one ball and practice the pattern. After the group has mastered one ball, introduce a second ball by having two people start throwing at the same time.

Then move on to three, four five up to however many people there are in the group. Once you have a large number of balls being juggled it creates the illusion of a very complex feat!

#### How To Win:

This is a game where team work and group participation are encouraged.

#### Items Required to Play The Game:

- Three to six balls such as tennis balls.
- The same number of balls as there are people is desirable.
- Small bean bags can be used as well.
